

TENTATIVE CONNECTIONS FOR GENEALOGIES OF SNP GROUP R1-228b-SUBGROUP 3

NOTES: This chart is based on DNAAchart228-connections.pdf, and shows male lines of descent only, since the focus is on using Y-DNA analysis to trace the Graves surname.
 The number in each bottom colored box is the DNA test ID. When two descendants of a common ancestor have exactly the same DNA test results, it is assumed that the common ancestor also had that result, and all boxes up to and including the common ancestor have been given the same color.
 24 of 25 means that 24 of the 25 markers matched the inferred ancestral haplotype.
 A notation like 13-19 indicates a mutation from the ancestral haplotype, and means marker 13 had a value of 19.
 The inferred ancestral haplotype is the series of 37 numbers with no white squares in the large blue area of the master DNA results table.

The positioning of the relationship of the various genealogies to each other on this chart is based partly on the DNA results and partly on known genealogical information and deduction. When an exact connection for one genealogy to another is proven, the genealogies will be combined. Until that time, the relationships shown on this chart should be considered to be tentative and conjectural. All help to improve this chart will be welcomed.
