

# Graves Family of Lincolnshire, England (R1-083)

Including Gen. 83 (Samuel Graves of Lynn, MA) and Gen. 428 & 457 and Taylor & Willis, (Rev. 26 Feb. 2021)

**NOTES:**  
 (1) This chart shows male lines of descent only. There are probably other male lines from Samuel Graves that are not presently known.  
 (2) "No descendant" means no known male descendant or male descendants not known.  
 (3) Part of the reason the lines from Samuel1, Thomas2, Samuel3 have been expanded to show more detail is that genealogy 457 is believed to descend from this branch, and it is hoped this will help the connection to be found.  
 (4) The number in each bottom colored box is the DNA test ID. 24 of 25 means that 24 of the 25 DNA markers matched the inferred ancestral haplotype. 13-19 indicates a mutation from the ancestral haplotype, and means marker 13 had a value of 19.  
 (5) This chart now includes all Big Y tests, including terminal SNPs and Private Variants. Big Y tests are needed from more descendants. In general, the more private variants a Big Y tester has, the more chance for another tester to create a new SNP. Big Y testing is an opportunity to better define and confirm relationships within a genealogy, to find relationships between genealogies, and to learn more about the origins of genealogies.
